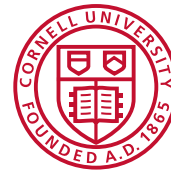

Community Engagement Knowledge Check

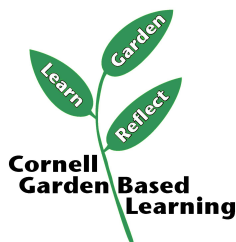
