Always:

- ✓ **Check pesticide records before entering**
- ✓ **Double check by talking or texting with the grower**
- ✓ **Wear Nitrile N-DEX chemical resistant gloves**

Your Safety Your responsibility!

- If a greenhouse smells funny DON'T GO IN!



- Be consistent. Scouting the same day each week will help insure a grower doesn't spray just before you scout.
