Chickweed	Low-growing, mat-forming weed with small white star-shaped flowers; thrives in moist, shaded areas	
Henbit	Square stems, purple tubular flowers, rounded leaves with scalloped edges; often blooms early in spring.	
Purple Deadnettle	Square stems, purple tubular flowers, rounded leaves with scalloped edges; often blooms early in spring.	
Shepherds Purse	Recognizable by its heart-shaped seed pods; commonly appears in disturbed soils and garden beds.	
Hairy Bittercress	Small white flowers and explosive seed pods; often one of the first weeds to flower in spring.

Annual Bluegrass	Bright green, low-growing grass that can flower even when mowed short; common in lawns and beds.	
Cheatgrass (Downy Brome)	Fine-textured grass with drooping seed heads; often found in disturbed or bare soil areas.
