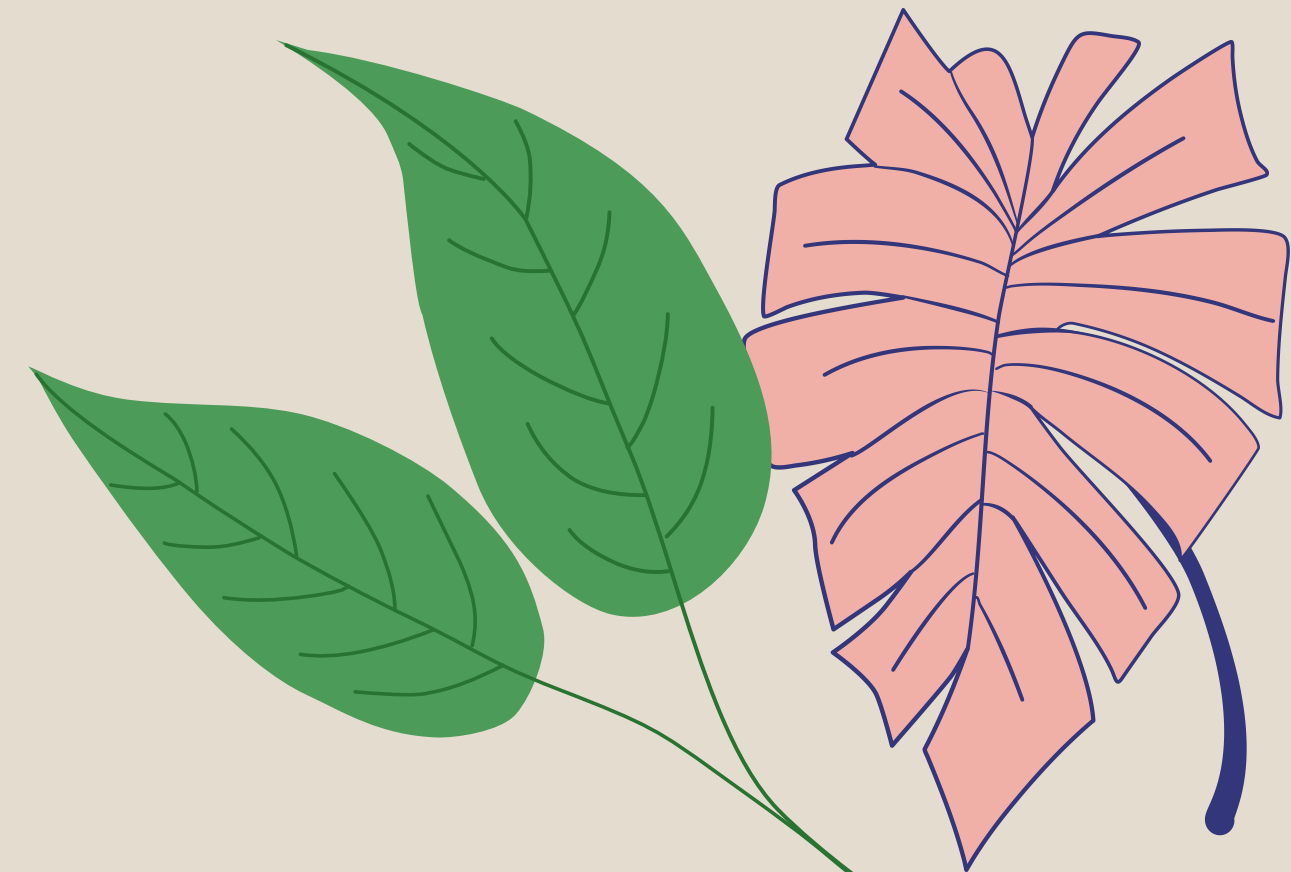


# Introductory Statement

Implement eco-friendly practices to nurture the ecosystem while cultivating a vibrant garden space.

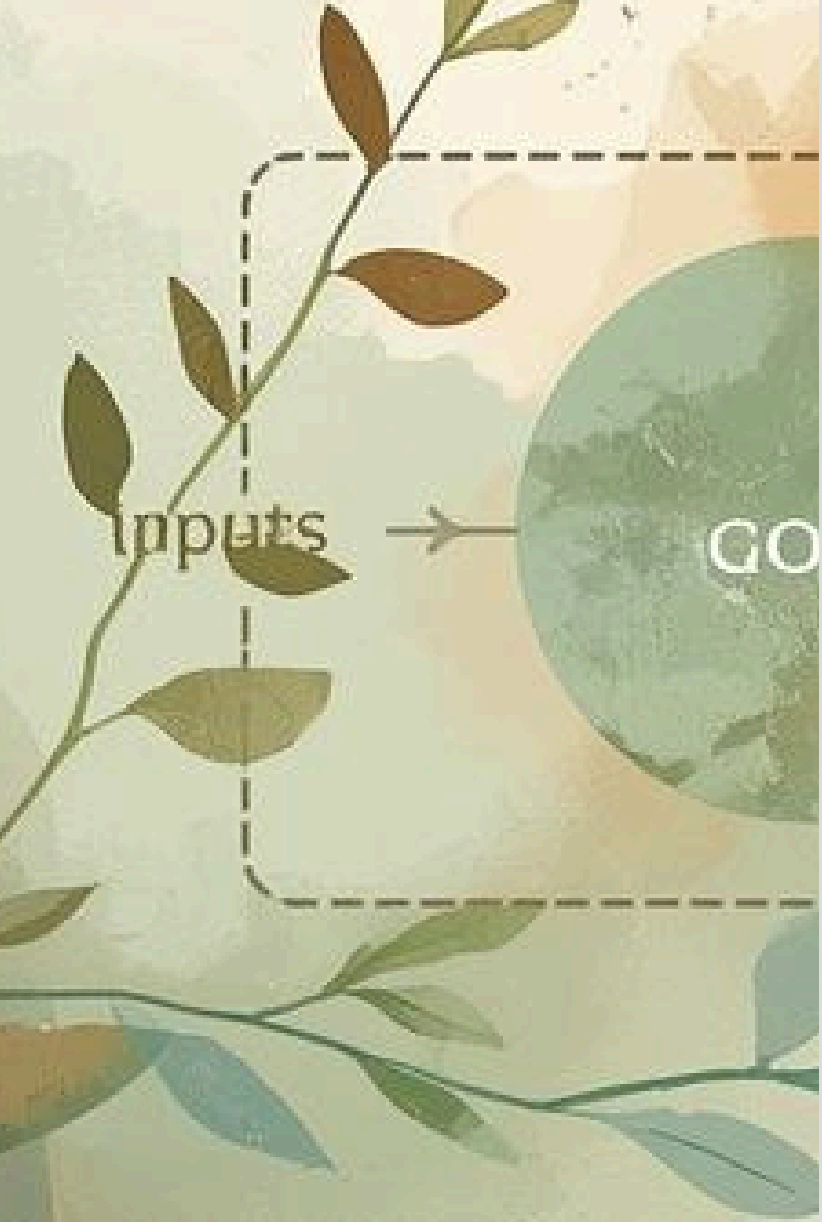

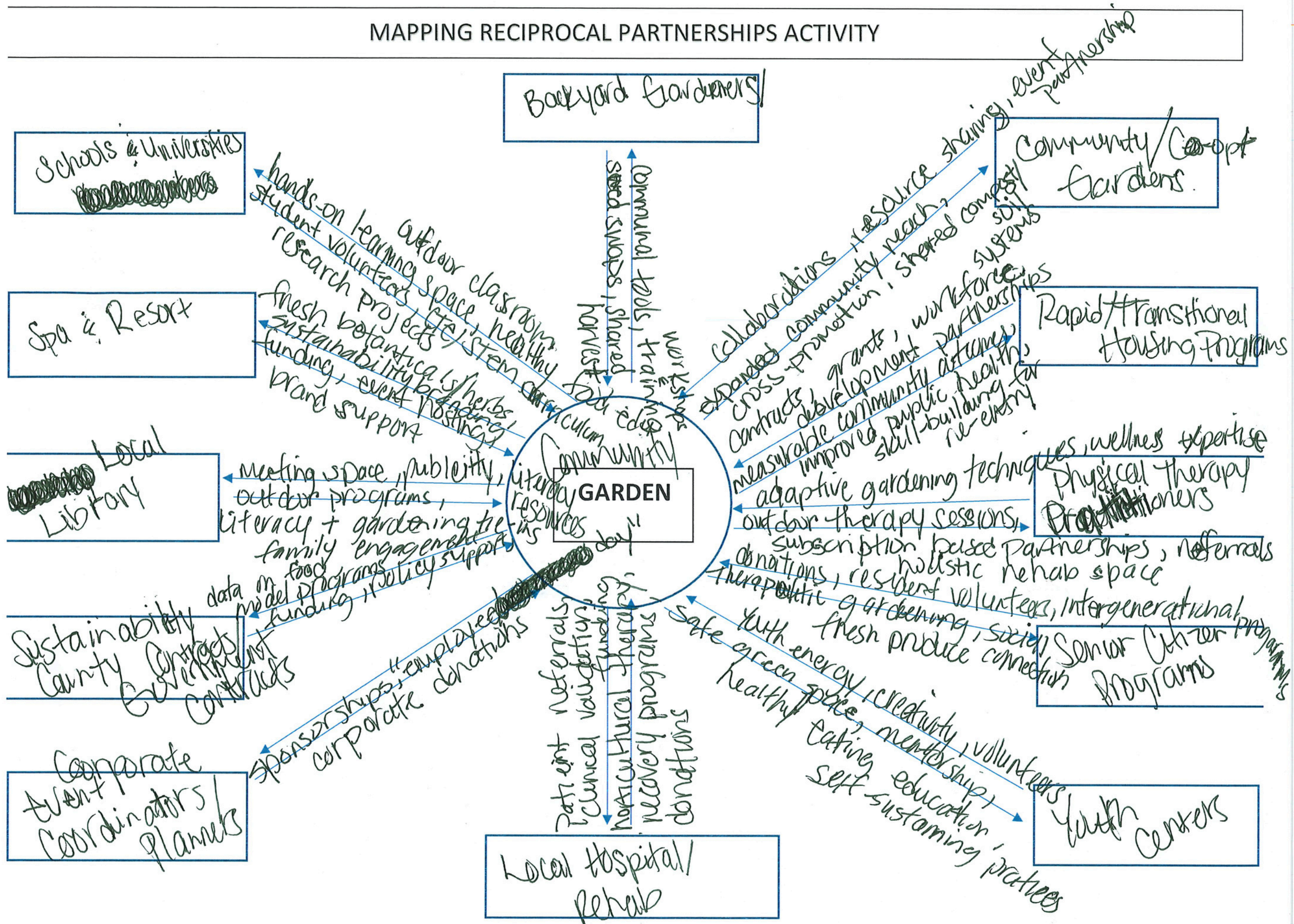

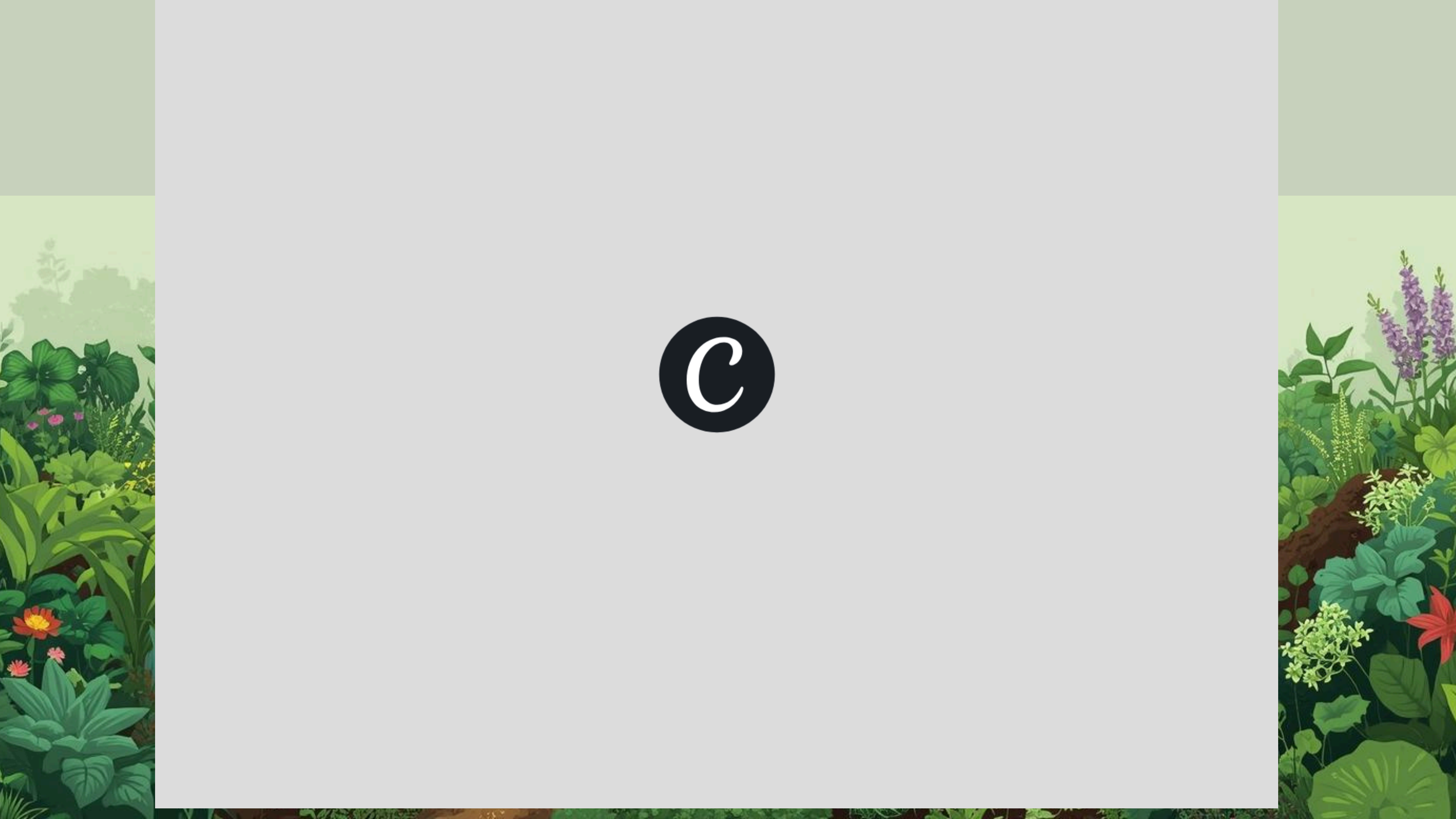
## **Metrics for Assessing Program Success**

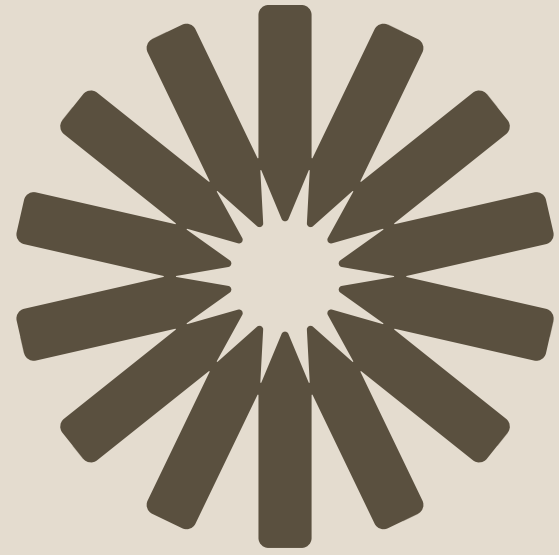
